At Woodcrest Retreat you will reconnect with God and each other as your family relaxes around a crackling campfire. Meet other camping families that share your faith and values in a welcoming and friendly camp setting.

Shaded campsites with fire rings and picnic tables: 15 water/electric/sewer sites, 36 water/electric sites, and an area for tenting.

Bathrooms and showers are close by, and a dumping station is available. There is a small Camp Store; ice and firewood are available for

Circle Pavilion—Groups renting 10 sites or more for two nights are welcome to reserve the Circle Pavilion at no additional cost.



Indian Rock Center (IRC)—groups renting 6 sites or more for two nights are welcome to reserve the Indian Rock Center (a fully enclosed building) for an additional cost. Each of the above has a kitchen, serving tables, and tables for guests.



Don't have a camper or tent? Try these.

Flicker and Wren cabins sleep 8 each in 1 double size bunk and 2 single size bunk beds on regular mattresses. Includes sofas, kitchen, cold running water, outdoor picnic tables and fire ring. Restrooms nearby.



Adirondack Shelters — 8 rustic accommodations that sleep 10 in bunk beds on foam mattresses (no electric). A sturdy and dry alternative to tenting. Includes picnic tables and fire rings.



Rock Haven—a furnished residential house trailer that can sleep 11 in three bedrooms. Guests provide their own linens. Includes full bath, fully equipped kitchen with basic utensils and two sitting areas.
