# AFFORDABLE Christ-centered family camping



At Woodcrest Retreat you will reconnect with God and each other as your family relaxes around a crackling campfire. Meet other camping families that share your faith and values in a welcoming and friendly camp setting.

**Shaded campsites** with fire rings and picnic tables: 36 with water/electric, 10 primitive sites, and an area for tenting.

**Bathrooms and showers** are close by, and a dumping station is available. There is a small Camp Store; ice and firewood are available for purchase.



Woodcrest is a great place to hold a family reunion, small group, or church retreat!

**Circle Pavilion**—Groups renting 10 sites or more for two nights are welcome to reserve the Circle Pavilion at no additional cost.



**Indian Rock Center (IRC)**—groups renting 6 sites or more for two nights are welcome to reserve the Indian Rock Center (a fully enclosed building) for an additional cost. Each of the above has a kitchen, serving tables, and tables for guests.

Don't have a camper or tent? Try these.

**Adirondack Shelters** — 8 rustic accommodations that sleep 10 in bunk beds on foam mattresses (no electric). A sturdy and dry alternative to tenting. Includes picnic tables and fire rings.



**Flicker and Wren cabins** sleep 8 each in double size bunk beds on regular mattresses. Includes sofas, kitchen, cold running water, outdoor picnic tables and fire ring. Restrooms nearby.



**RV camper** sleeps 2 with restroom, small kitchen, large deck, fire ring, and picnic table.
