## CAMPGROUND & LODGING POLICICES

- Check-in time is 5:00 P.M. Check-out time is 4:00 P.M.
- Register at office upon arrival.
- Day Guest Fees apply to those who are not overnight guests, additional charges for Day Guests using waterslide and pool.
- One vehicle per campsite.
- May stay and enjoy grounds after checkout.
- Single girls and guys must sleep in separate areas of facility.
- A minimum of one adult leader for every ten youth.
- TV, DVD player, computer projector, and portable sound system are available for fee. Adult supervision required.
- Bike riding is permitted from 7:00 AM to dusk. Please stay off concrete walk at Indian Rock Center. Follow PA bike helmet guidelines. Failure to do so is at your own risk.
- All fires must be built in rings provided, and attended at all times. Make sure the fire is out before retiring for the night.
- Anything broken will be the group's responsibility.
- Buildings and Campsites should be cleaned before departure.

## GENERAL RETREAT POLICIES

- Quiet hours: 11:00 PM - 7:00 AM.  
Also, during the day, please respect other retreat guests and their activities.
- Modesty expected.
  - Females: Required swimwear is a modest one-piece or tankini that covers the mid-rift. Cover-ups and footwear must be worn when away from water activities.
  - Males: Swimwear is to reach mid thigh and a shirt and footwear must be worn when away from water activities. Exception: When a game requires one team to go shirtless.
  - Children: Play clothes or cover-ups and footwear must be worn when away from water activities.
- Please allow flowers, plants and animals to remain in their natural environment.
- Please help us conserve energy by avoiding excessive use of electricity.
- Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are prohibited.
- Smoking is discouraged and is not permitted in buildings or pavilions.
- Dancing is not allowed for pleasure and enjoyment purposes. It may be used as an expression of honor and glory to God as part of worship services.
- No pets are permitted in any buildings. Clean up after your pet.
- ATV's and dirt bikes are not permitted on retreat property.
- Firearms and fireworks are prohibited.
- Volleyball courts and baseball diamonds are for all retreat users and are on a first-come basis, unless scheduled with the office.
- Sports equipment should be returned in good condition to their appropriate holders.
- Garbage should be emptied and placed in dumpster. Clean liners should be placed in cans.
- Report all maintenance needs to the office.
