# Family Campground

To ensure that Pennsylvanians have opportunities to safely enjoy outdoor recreation as a way to maintain positive physical and mental health, Governor Tom Wolf announced the lifting of some restrictions on businesses related to certain outdoor activities.

As such Woodcrest is excited to open up our campground for the 2020 season. For the time being (until permitted by the state) the following guidelines have been issued. It is up to the individual families to observe these guidelines but please be mindful of other guests.

- Practice physical distancing: Maintain the recommended minimum six feet apart from fellow recreationists. Pennsylvanians are also encouraged to wear a mask or protective garment that covers the nose and mouth any time they go outside.
- Minimize risk to others: Individuals should only go out if they feel healthy and have not been recently exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Practice good hygiene: Wash hands often with soap and warm water for 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer containing at least 60 percent alcohol.

To help keep guests safe, use the playground at your discretion. Restrooms and shower facilities will be cleaned more frequently by our staff. **Our camp store, activity den, and other indoor facilities will not open at this time.** As restrictions are lifted we will be ready to comply to offer additional amenities and to ensure that all Woodcrest guests have an enjoyable and safe time.
