


HELLO WOODCREST FAMILIES,

We know that you probably have lots of other things on your mind and hope that we can provide a little peace of mind by answering some questions you might have about summer camp.



Q: Will camp happen?

A: We can answer that question more confidently than have for the past few months. We are able to run all 8 weeks of our Discovery and Trekker Day Camps. The first sessions will begin June 15th. Unfortunately, at this point we are unable to open our popular overnight camps. We have cancelled the first two weeks of overnight. However, we have created a new camp—Wilderness Day Camp. This is a great alternative to overnight. It is up to 12 hours of action packed fun and adventure every day. We are running Wilderness Day Camp June 22-26 in place of Pioneer 1 camp. It is for campers age 8-11. See more details below.

Q: Is Woodcrest take extra precautions in response to Covid-19?

Woodcrest is diligently reviewing all of the guidelines set forth by the CDC, the American Camp Association, the Association of Camp Nurses, as well as our local and state health departments. Additionally, we have been in conversation with local and regional people from various fields to help us form and review policies related to the care of our campers this summer. This fields include health, insurance, legal, and other camping professionals.

Q: What are some of those precautions?

A: At Woodcrest your child's safety is already our top priority. Considering the recent pandemic, we are prepared to make modifications to our programming to keep Woodcrest a safe place. This includes limiting group sizes, instituting a rigorous sanitation schedule, modifying how meals are served, as well as changes to our health screening and registration processes. A fuller explanation of our new policies are included with your parent check-in packet. Furthermore, we have added additional staff to help maintain and serve our campers to make sure all areas are frequently cleaned and to help us follow through on new policies in food service, support staff, and health care.

Q: Is Woodcrest making any pricing changes to reflect the national economy?

A: We know finances are a real concern right now for many. To help families during this challenging time, we have extended early bird pricing through July 6th. Camp scholarships are also available. You can check out our website to download an application. If you have special needs or concerns, please call our office at 717-738-2233 and we will work with you.

Q: What is Wilderness Day Camp?

A: We believe that camp is too valuable and important to just simply close our doors this summer. When we learned that we couldn't open overnight camps in June we quickly moved to create Wilderness Day Camp. Using are already trained and gifted staff, we are offering this unique program to children 8-11 who are local enough to travel to and from camp on a daily basis. Parents have the flexibility of dropping campers offer between 7:00-9:00 in the morning. The day will be filled with most of the same activities campers would do during overnight including choice activities, cooking some of their own meals over a campfire, swimming, crafts and nature, Bible studies, and so much more. All of that with the memory creating relationships that make summer camp so special. Campers can be picked at parents' convenience up to 8:00 each evening. We are asking parents who can pay the original overnight price of \$290 knowing that it is really the same expenses to run this program. Those families who are unable to pay the full price can choose to pay a discounted price of \$225.
