

Woodcrest's Mask Policy

- Parents are expected to wear masks when picking up and dropping off campers. Woodcrest staff involved in the check-in and pick-up will also be wearing masks.
- Woodcrest staff are always expected to have their mask on their possession and would put on their masks when working one on one with a camper where physical distancing cannot be maintained.
- Woodcrest staff will wear masks when entering Indian Rock Center for meals. Food service staff will also wear masks while serving food to campers.
- We ask parents to consider sending their camper to camp with a mask that can be worn at the parent's or child's discretion (i.e. when working one on one with a counselor where physical distancing cannot be maintained).
- It is our desire to promote a culture where wearing masks is acceptable so that if a camper is wearing a mask, they can feel accepted and can belong to the group. We would not promote masks to be worn when campers are running and doing physical activity outside where wearing a mask is actually detrimental to the campers' wellbeing.
- As a private, religious organization we are seeking to honor the spirit of the current requirements while facing the realities of running a predominantly outdoor program for children and youth.
- We will continue to take daily temperature checks for day campers upon arrival and regular checks for overnight campers during the week. We are maintaining our other protective measures of limited groups sizes, increased sanitation, and restricting certain program activities. These are all designed as forms of reasonable mitigation to prevent a spread of any virus or pathogen.
- We will continue to work hard to follow guidelines and recommendations from the CDC, American Camp Association, Association of Camp Nursing, Christian Camp and Conference Association, and local and state guidelines. As such Woodcrest's covid-19 practices may change as those guidelines and recommendations change. We will try to keep parents informed on any significant changes that are made.
