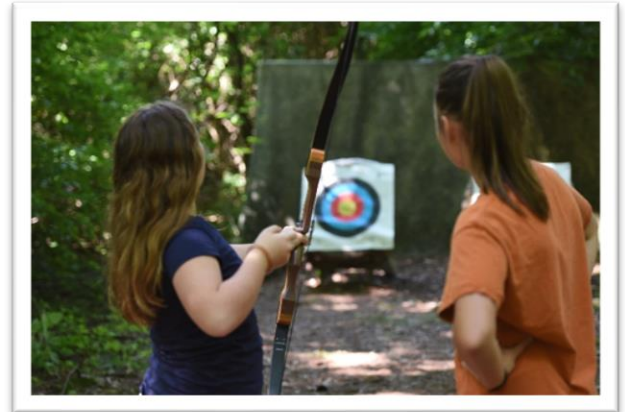


Woodcrest Retreat Summer Camp
