

Hello Journey to Bethlehem Guests,

Thank you for your interest in the Journey experience this year. We truly believe that the message of Jesus and His promise of great joy unto all people is needed this year.

We have been closely following the Pennsylvania governor's new guidelines. Although we fall under the religious exemption because of our 501C(3) religious status, we are still making modifications that will significantly limit the waiting time indoors. Please read our new registration procedures.

Arrival: Please arrive between 15 minutes before your registered timeslot and 15 minutes after the beginning of your timeslot. For example: If you are signed up for the 6:00-6:30 slot, plan on arriving between 5:45-6:15. This will prevent all 100 people showing up at the same time.

30 at a time: We can take 30 guests on a tour at a time. To limit indoor waiting, we will take the first 30 in line for the next tour. We will have a staff member indicating where the next 30 people ends. This will allow families and groups to arrange themselves outside to make sure they are together. Our staff will work with groups to help ensure that they are together as much as possible.

Limited Inside Waiting: This process means that the only time guests should be inside is when they are waiting to register and pay. We have added an outdoor waiting area for the group that is on standby to go on the tour. All other waiting will be done outside where guests can physically distance themselves being sensitive to those around them.

Your Patience: We appreciate your patience as we put these new steps in place as it may take a while to work out the kinks and have a smooth registration system.

The rest: Once you are on the bus, groups sizes are below the recommended 50. The windows in the buses will be open and families can spread out. We are also encouraging guests to wear face covering on the buses to be sensitive to those around them. Once off the bus we ask families to be sensitive to other guests in terms of space. Let us all demonstrate Christian love this Christmas season.

Monitor Yourself: As always, if you are feeling sick or believe you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive, please refrain from coming. If you have any hesitations, although we would love to have you experience the Journey, your peace of mind is important. Know your limitations, especially if you are in a higher risk group.

As staff and volunteers we are covering this event in prayer and believe that we can offer a safe space for people to enjoy the Journey and experience the power of the Christmas message.
