Mission 4:12 Begins

Woodcrest kicked off our next building initiative at our spring banquet. Having experienced continued growth in all areas of our ministry, the Board of Directors identified a building plan that enables us to manage current needs while laying the foundation for continued Kingdom impact for the future.

With the funding secured for our soon-to-be-completed shower house, we are excited to move into the next phase. Phase Two is focused on replacing our eight bunkhouses with 10 Lancaster Log Cabins. These cabins (modeled after our new Meadowlark Cabin) will keep the rustic culture that makes Woodcrest unique, while providing year-round facilities for new programming. (continue on page 2)

Mission 4:12 Continued:

Currently, the bunkhouses get limited use outside of summer. We have a vision of running our own winter retreats, as well as providing space for churches to run their own retreats for up to 140 people. When completed, the cabins will let us increase our overnight camp enrollment and provide better lodging for summer staff. These cabins will also be used for family programing and overnight school retreats through the School of Wonder—our outdoor education ministry. Each cabin will have a bathroom, electricity, and a spacious porch.

Phase Two will also include a second shower house providing each cabin with convenient restroom facilities. These upgrades require expansion of our current sewer line and underground infrastructure throughout the Poplar View area. Our current construction cost is estimated to be \$150,000 for each cabin and \$300,000 for the additional shower house, for a total cost of \$1.8 million for Phase Two. This is an ambitious project!

We take this faith-filled risk after spending a year in prayer seeking God's leading and direction on how to pursue our mission for greater Gospel impact. At our recent banquet, Bill, our Executive Director, shared stories from the life of Hudson Taylor and his mission to share the gospel in China. When addressing the enormity of this project, Bill shared this quote from Taylor, "You can depend on it! God's work done in God's way will never lack God's supply." We are trusting God to provide for the work that He is doing here at Woodcrest.

There are lots of ways for you to join us on this mission to complete Phase Two. Praying for Woodcrest is something everyone can do and is vital to the ministry. A good summer program is birthed out of lots of planning and intentionality. Woodcrest needs to hire 65 staff and secure 30 camp volunteers plus 16 Bible teachers to do that well. God has provided the right people for each of these positions. We are still trusting God to provide the roughly 80 kitchen volunteers that are needed to help serve meals.

Of course, we love children and God is filling our summer camps with children who will hear the Gospel and see God's love

demonstrated through our caring staff. We expect nearly 2,000 campers again this summer. Join us in praying for a mighty work of God. Our Fall Fest continues to grow. This year we have several new components that will certainly make this the best festival yet. In fact, it is so good that one day wasn't enough. We are making it a Family Fun Weekend. Family-friendly activities will begin Friday night and end Sunday morning with a Woodcrest inspired Fireside worship time. Reserve a campsite or cabin to make sure you don't miss any of the fun.

Saturday is the big day. We have secured some amazing food vendors including homemade soft pretzels, freeze squeezed lemonade, our apple cider slushies, fresh fries, and so much more. Our silent auction is a great way to support Woodcrest and is back with great items and experiences. Children will love all of the games and activities, including the popular gaga tournament. There will be wagon rides, crafts, and so much more happening in the Poplar View area.

New this year will be a pulled pork dinner. Tickets can be reserved online or by calling the camp office. The full menu and details can also be found on our event page. All proceeds benefit our new Mission 4:12 campaign.

The evening culminates with a benefit concert. Piercing Word will open the evening with a special performance of their Scripture-based shows. Following that, Christian singer Steve Green will perform. Steve has been the Dove Award winner seven times and was inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame in 2017. During his 36 years in ministry, he has recorded 18 number one songs and sold over 3 million albums worldwide. We are excited to have him join us. It is a free concert but we encourage people to reserve space through our event page. An offering will be taken that will go toward our capital campaign.
