Adventure Camps

RISE Staff-in-Training Program

RISE is a two-week overnight program for those intent on growing as a Christian and as a leader. It is the capstone camp experience for any camper wondering, "What is it like to be on staff?", with off-site trips, service projects, outdoor skills challenges, and even shadowing a day camp counselor in action. Campers must apply and be accepted into RISE.



Outbound French Creek

Outbound Assateague Island

A multi-day backcountry canoe and camping trip. Enjoy campfire cooking at bay-side campsites and walk to sunny beach-side dunes.

Outbound West Virginia

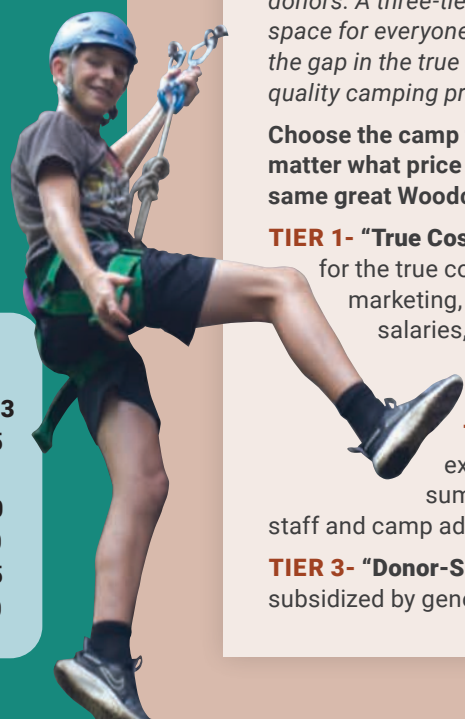
Get into the Appalachian mountains and out of the ordinary. Enjoy outfitted mountain biking and white water rapids as you explore all that West Virginia has to offer.

Choose the camp fee that works for you! No matter what price tier you choose, you get the same great Woodcrest camping experience.

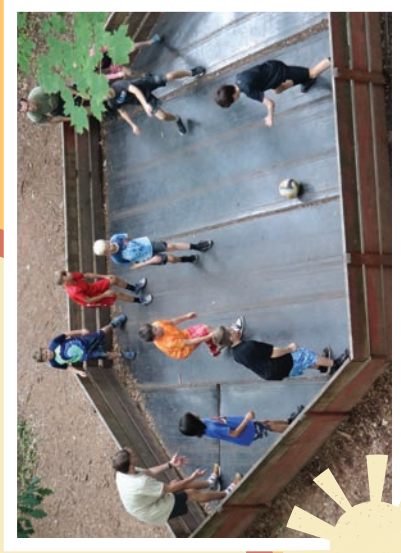
