Safety procedures will be followed and kids will have a great time making some edible atoms while learning about the amazing way God created the chemical world.







- An **Emergency Contact Release Form** needs to be completed each semester so that School of Wonder staff have access to parents in case of emergency during class time. That form is available on our School of Wonder page of our website and at each class.
- **Payment** can be made by mailing a check to Woodcrest Retreat. Credit Card payment can be made over the phone or by stopping in the office prior to your registered class.
