

Woodcrest Retreat Pool Rules

- All persons using the pool, or pool area, do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. The management does not assume responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with the use of the pool. The cost of any property damage will be charged to the responsible party.
- All persons must use the facility in conformity with all rules and regulations. Running, rough play and conduct not conducive to safety are prohibited in the pool and pool area. Disrespect toward the authority of the LIFEGUARDS is not acceptable. Any person may be denied admission or asked to leave without refund to the pool area for violation of the rules and regulations at the discretion of facility leadership.
- Management reserves the right to limit the number of guests admitted in the event of overcrowding.
- Modest swimwear is required:
 - Females: A one piece suit or tankini that covers the midriff. A dark colored T-shirt must be worn if midriff is exposed. Cover-ups and footwear must be worn when away from water activities.
 - Males: Boxer style suits that reach mid-thigh. Shirt and footwear must be worn when away from water activities.
- Everyone within the pool area will either need to be a season pass holder, a paying guest, or a retreat guest.
- Children, 12 years of age or under, MUST be accompanied by a responsible person of at least 16 years of age.
- Individuals who are not fully potty-trained (including babies, toddlers, and special needs individuals) are required to wear a swim diaper. It is recommended that an additional cover, such as a plastic reusable diaper cover, be worn over top of the swim diaper. Swim diapers are available for purchase at pool booth.
- Admission can be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eye infections or certain type of bandages.
- While food and beverages may be brought into the fenced pool area, it needs to be kept away from the water. Also, no glass bottles or containers are allowed in pool area.
- Please dispose of trash in the proper receptacles and recycling containers.
- No food, chewing gum or hard candy should be consumed while swimming.
- Voice levels should be kept at a level considerate of others. Foul language and other types of vulgar or disrespectful speech are not allowed.
- No PETS allowed within the pool area except for licensed service dogs.
- Ear buds and headphones must be used when playing music.
- Pool toys and balls may be used unless the lifeguards specify otherwise for the safety and comfort of other patrons.
- Chairs or tables may not be reserved and are available on a first come first serve basis.
- Smoking is discouraged and is not permitted within 100 feet of any building or pavilion. No smoking allowed within the fenced pool area!
- Pool Staff have the right to close the pool for weather, chemical, and safety issues without any refunds. Swimmers will be able to return to the pool when management has deemed it safe to swim.
- Only US Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs) are allowed in the shallow areas of the pool. Any children using floatation devices must be within arm's reach of their parent or guardian. PFDs may not be used in the diving area.
- We ask that nursing mothers be discrete and cover up while nursing or use the benches in the air-conditioned lady's restroom.
- Please observe and follow all posted signs at the pool and waterslide areas.

SEASON POOL PASS POLICIES

- A season pass grants access to the pool area only. It DOES NOT include use of pavilions or other rental activities.
- The waterslide is included with a season pass and is open on Saturdays and Sundays from 1:30 to 3:30.
- Any adults who accompany children to the pool and are not Season Pool Pass holders, must still pay the admission price, even if they do not intend to swim.
- Pool pass holders are permitted to bring guests. Guests will need to pay the appropriate admission price.
