



Woodcrest Retreat Discovery Day Camp Summer 2026 Check-In Packet

Packing for Camp!

In a bag or backpack, please label and send the following items every day with your camper:

- Water Bottle
- Sunscreen
- Swimsuit (see dress guidelines on the FAQ page of our website)
- Towel
- Rain Gear (as needed)

Campers should wear **modest, casual clothing** suitable for outdoor play and camp activities. **Appropriate footwear** for running and hiking is required.

Welcome!

Thank you for registering your child for Woodcrest Retreat's Discovery Day Camp! We look forward to providing a fun, safe, faith-filled camp experience for your child. Please read the material in this packet carefully as it will help ensure that you and your child have a great camp experience.

MULTI-WEEK CAMPERS: If your child is signed up for multiple weeks of day camp, you will receive this information packet more than once, but you only need to resubmit forms if the information changes. Please note that you do need to go through the registration line each week.

TICK PREVENTION: We recommend that you use a permethrin based spray (common brand is Sawyer) on your child's shoes and backpack prior to camp to help reduce contact with ticks.

First Morning Check-in

Registration is open from 8:00-8:45 at the Indian Rock Center (Follow signs to the first building on the left).

Daily Drop Off

On the other mornings of camp, campers should arrive between 8:45-9:00.

Daily Pick-up

Children should be picked up between 3:45-4:00 each day. Parents/Guardians need photo ID to sign out campers and must be included on the approved camper pick-up form. Additional parking is available in the campsites above and below the main parking lot.

Late Drop-Offs/Early Pickups

Late drop-off, early pickup, and other summer camp related questions can be handled in our Summer Camp Office, found in the lower level of the Indian Rock Center.

Needed for First Day

- Final Payment — If you have not pre-paid, you will need to use the "Payment" line at registration. Woodcrest accepts cash, checks and credit card for payment.
- Medication Administration Form (enclosed if needed). All medications must be in original, labeled container.

Completed Before Camp

These forms are found on your child's profile account on our registration portal.

- Authorization for Camper Pickup — Anyone allowed to pickup your child from camp
- Online Medical Form
- Final Payment (preferred)

Discovery Day Camp FAQ

- ◆ What is Woodcrest's refund policy?

All deposits are non-refundable & non-transferable. No refunds will be given except for medical emergencies. Children that are sent home for inappropriate behavior or homesickness are not eligible for a refund.
- ◆ What if I forgot an item for my child?

In order to provide a safe environment for all campers, visitors are discouraged and must be approved by the administration. All guests must register at the Summer Camp Office (located in the lower level of the Indian Rock Center) before proceeding into camp. If you need to drop off an item label it with their name and leave it in the office. Camp leadership will pick it up there and give it to your camper.
- ◆ Will my child be required to take a swim test?

For the safety of our campers, all campers must take a swim test before entering the pool. The pool is supervised by both counselors and certified lifeguards.
- ◆ What should I do if my camper has special dietary needs?

We are limited in our ability to accommodate special diets. If your camper needs a special diet please bring prepared food, labeled by meal, for them to check-in. We will make sure it is stored properly and is given to them at the appropriate time. Make sure all allergies are noted on the camper medical form.
- ◆ What if my camper has a BHT/TSS?

Support for your camper is allowed in the Discovery Day Camp program but must be arranged in advance. If your child has BHT/TSS services and you have not already spoken with us about them coming to camp please contact the office as soon as possible.
- ◆ Should my child have spending money?

Our snack bar is open during most pool hours. Items available at the snack bar include: soft pretzels, hot pockets, slushies, ice cream, candy bars, etc. Items range from \$0.50 - \$5.00.
- ◆ What is Woodcrest's clothing guidelines?

All clothing should be modest and suitable for outdoor activities. Please avoid clothing with images or wording contrary to Christian principles. Shorts should be mid-thigh or longer and not form fitting (please no writing on backside). Avoid form fitting or low cut shirts. Midriff must be covered. Any tank tops need wide shoulder straps. **Woodcrest requires close-toed footwear or sturdy sandals for safety reasons.** Flip flops are only permitted when going to and from the pool or showers. Jewelry is generally discouraged in the active, outdoor setting of camp. Loose or dangling jewelry such as hoop earrings can pose a safety hazard.

SWIMSUIT POLICY: Girls should wear a modest one-piece swimsuit or a tankini as long as the midriff is covered. Boys should wear a swimsuit that is mid-thigh or longer.
- ◆ In what scenario would Woodcrest send my child home early?

In the event that a camper's behavior is a hindrance to the rights or safety of others or the program, Woodcrest Retreat reserves the right to dismiss the camper upon consultation with the parent.
- ◆ What items are not allowed at camp?

ELECTRONICS SHOULD STAY AT HOME! - Summer camp provides children with a great opportunity to 'unplug' from their daily routine in a fun and exciting way. Woodcrest is also a place where we strive to put relationships with one another and God first. Electronic devices often hinder these goals and increase the likelihood of behavior problems. Toward that goal, children are to leave all electronics such as cell phones, music devices, apple watches and similar devices at home. Pocket knives are also not permitted at camp. Staff reserve the right to confiscate any item that compromises the safety, goals, and values of camp until dismissal at the end of the day.
